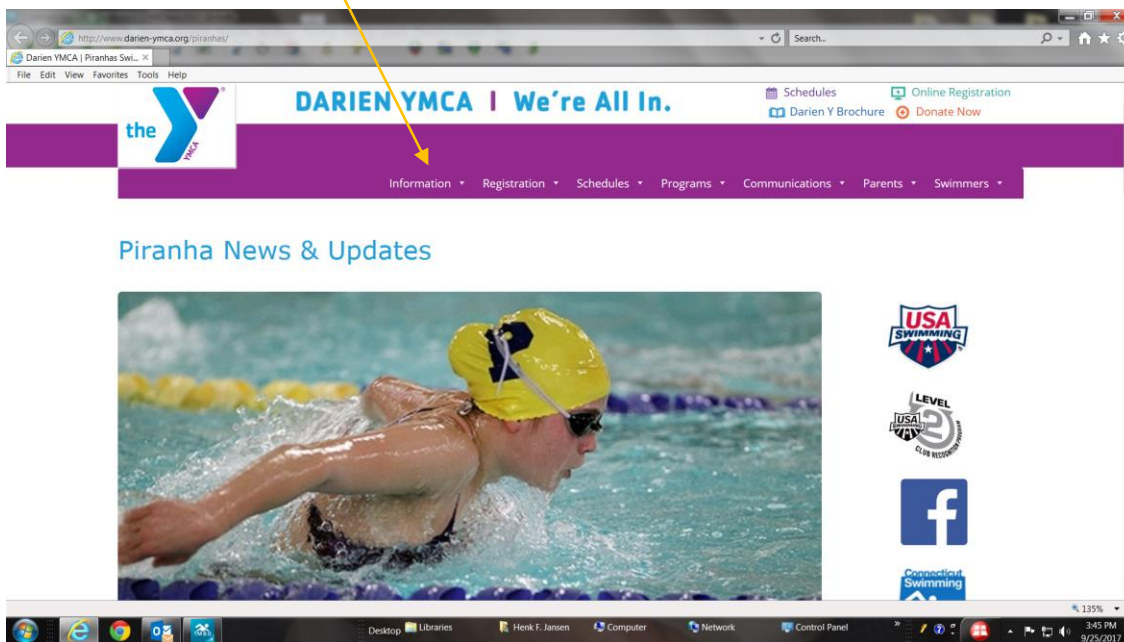
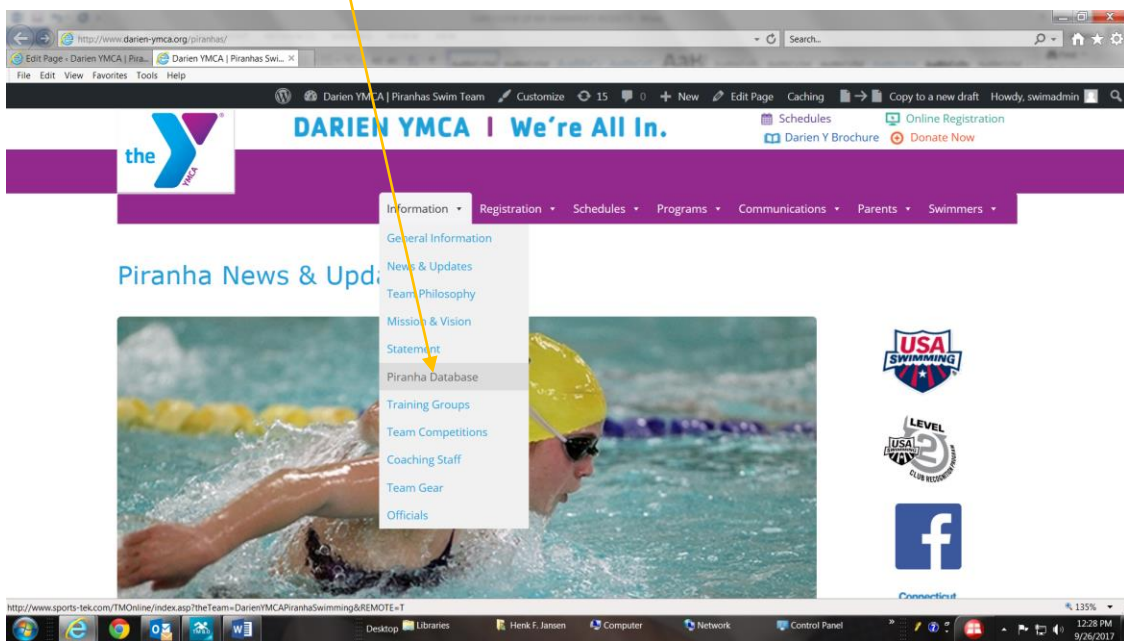


WHAT IS THE PIRANHA DATABASE?

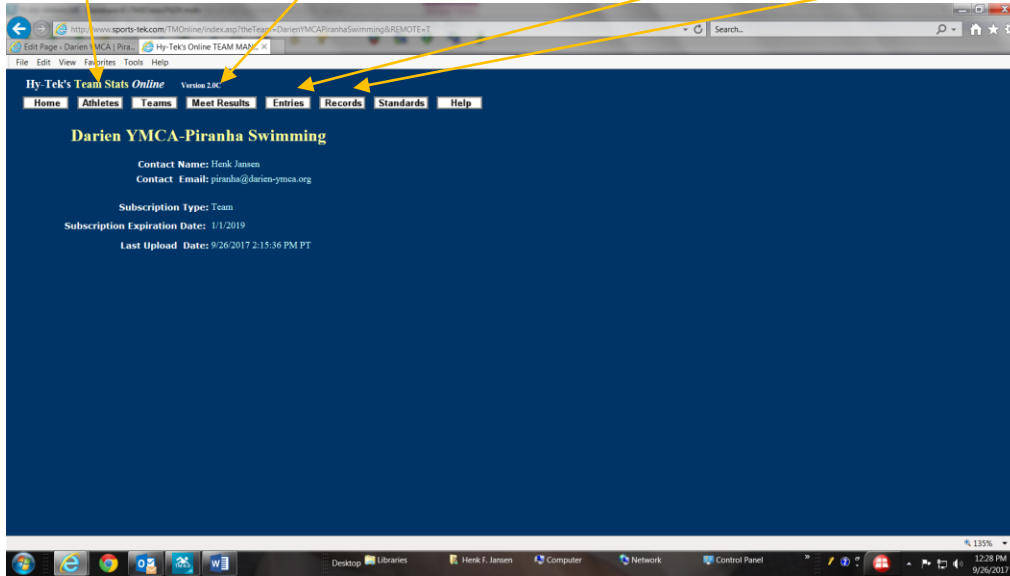
1. Click on the "Information" tab on the front page of the homepage.



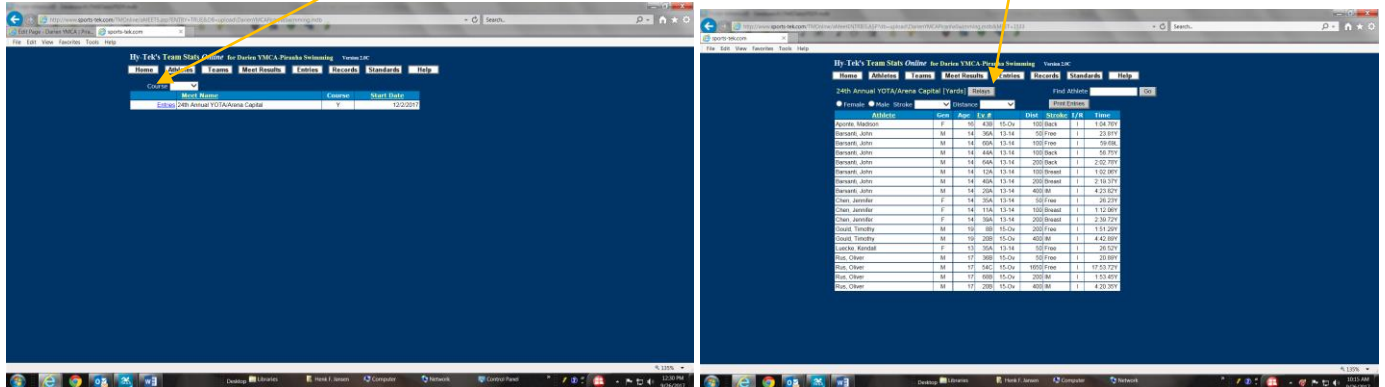
2. Choose "Piranha Database."



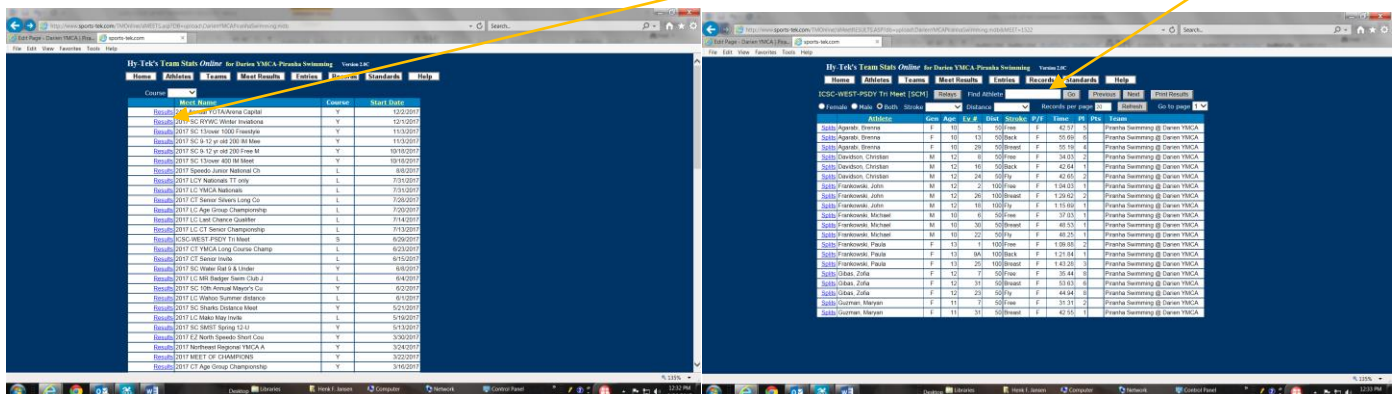
- This will open you up to a whole new world! Seriously, this is a one stop shop where you look up team records, swimmers on the Team, all meet results in the database and entries.



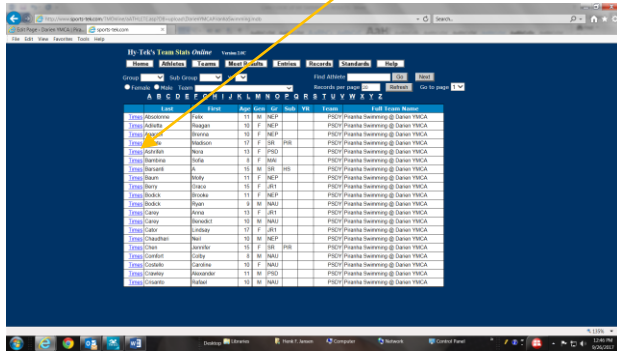
- This is an example if you click entry list. Click the link to the left and you will see the entry in alphabetical order by swimmer (please note events are not in numerical order – not sure why, so dumb). Exact same information on the “How do I find meet information..” tutorial.



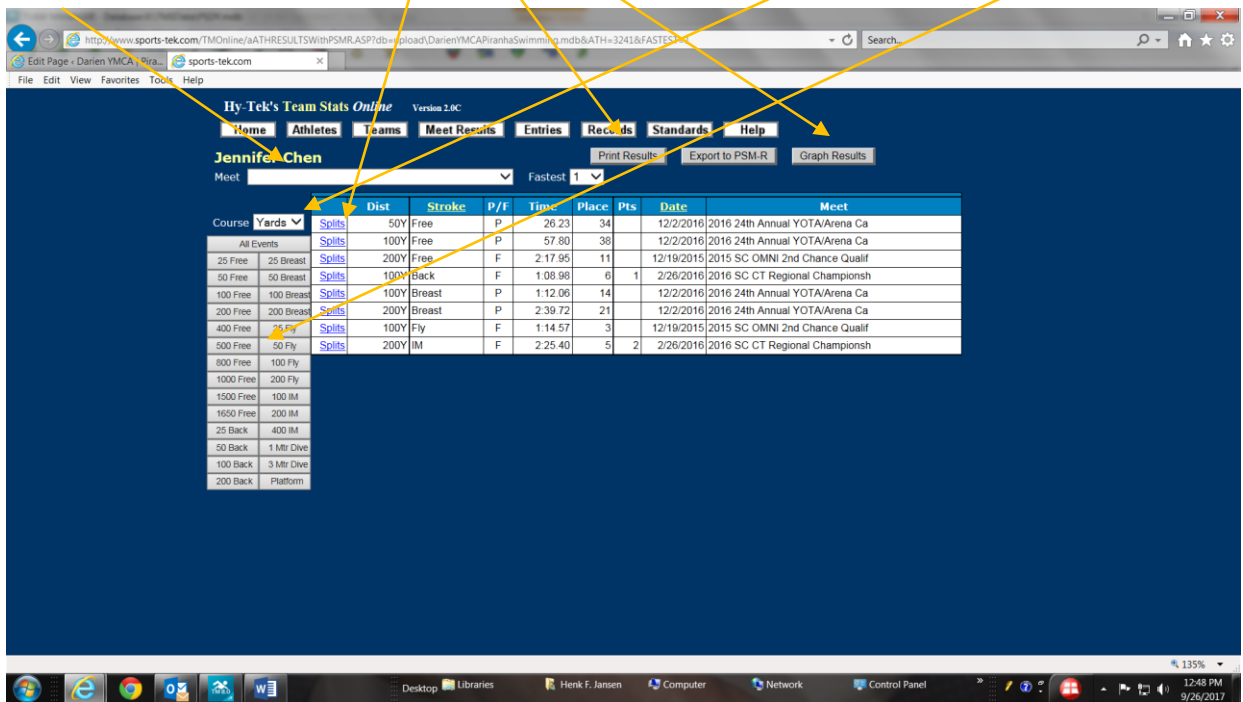
- This is an example if you click results list. This will show every meet in the database. Click the link and a results page will pop up. Kids are once again listed in alphabetical order. Exact same information on the “How do I find meet information..” tutorial.



6. One of the coolest features is when you click “Athletes.” A Team list pops up and you can choose your swimmer and see all his/her meet results. Click on the link to the left and a page dedicated to your swimmer will pop up.



At first it will show only that swimmer’s best times for the course selected (the default is SCY –short course yards), but if you change the parameters you can see more times and different courses (LCM – Long Course Meters – Olympic Distance). You can get splits, print, create a graph, change course, show only one event and select a specific meet.



7. To create a graph, you must select one distance from the left table and then click “graph results.” Graph shown that you can print out.
